Maharaja Agrasen Vidyalaya, Memnagar, Ahmedabad, an English Medium Co-educational Institute, was established by the Charitable Trust, "AGRAWAL SEWA SANSTHAN" and it is managed by the Vidyalaya Management Committee which has been constituted as per the norms for a Private Unaided Schools, as laid down by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), Delhi. It is located at Gurukul Road, Veer Savarkar Chowk, Near Sterling Hospital, Memnagar, Ahmedabad. The main aim of the Vidyalaya is to make the students useful member of the society having love for social service. All aspects (Physical, Mental, Social & Moral etc.) of a child's personality and his\her capabilities are developed.

The Vidyalaya is well known in the State for its high quality of education, discipline, systematic approach, honest dealings & great emphasis on Indian Culture and Values. The education in the Vidyalaya is not 'Examination and Information' oriented but 'Learning and Assimilation of Life Building Ideas'. A balance in Curricular, Co-curricular and Extra-curricular Activities is maintained. The training in Scouting & Guiding is also given to the students to inculcate the virtues like truthfulness, patriotism and service to the needy.

Our Foundations.....

The Foundation stone of the Vidyalaya building was laid down by the then Governor of Gujarat, Honourable Shri R. K. Trivedi, on 20th January, 1990. The imposing building of the Vidyalaya was inaugurated by Shri Phulchand Agrawal, Business Magnate & Industrialist and a Trustee of Agrawal Sewa Sansthan on 6th June, 1993.

The Foundations of the Vidyalaya lay deep down in the philanthropic vision of our esteemed Trustees and was even admired by the Honourable Governor of Gujarat State, Dr. Swarup Singh during his visit to the Vidyalaya on 3rd January, 1993. The Vidyalaya started functioning on 28th June 1993, with K.G. Class and Classes I to VI.

Where We Stand Now.....

The Vidyalaya has classes from I to XII along with K.G. Classes. There are 1700 students, 75 Teachers and 25 Non-teaching Staff Members, besides the Security and Care Taking Staff in sufficient number. At the +2 stage (Classes XI & XII), the Vidyalaya has the provision of teaching English, Mathematics/Psychology, Physics, Chemistry and Biology in the Science Stream and English, Economics, Business Studies, Accountancy and Mathematics/Geography in the Commerce Stream. Besides School also has the facility of counselling through a trained Psychologist.

Our Mission & Vision.....

The main aim of the Vidyalaya is to make the students useful member of the Society having love for social service. The motto of the Vidyalaya is "Enter to Learn, Go Out to Serve". All aspects (Physical, Mental, Social and Moral etc.) of a child's personality and his/her capabilities are to be developed so that he/she may play an important role in the ever changing complex society. The other objective is to make a pupil, a good learner, an efficient & disciplined worker and a compassionate human-being at large, having love and faith in "Bhartiya Jeevan Darshan".

Linguistically Wise.....

The medium of instruction in all classes is English, but the teaching of Hindi is as important as English. In Classes VI, VII and VIII, there is an option in Gujarati and Sanskrit i.e. Gujarati or Sanskrit is taught as third language as per CBSE, Delhi rules. The medium of instruction for teaching Gujarati and Sanskrit is Hindi.

Academic Excellence.....

Since 1998, when the students first appeared in the Board Examination, the school has witnessed 100% results and this trend has been maintained till date. Every year majority of students have scored distinction marks and a number of them have even been awarded 'Certificate of Merit' by CBSE, Delhi.

Our Infrastructure.....

The School Building is designed to give maximum space for all Curricular, Co-Curricular & ExtraCurricular Activities. It is a four storeyed building having 37 spacious Class-rooms with Interactive Boards, Besides 5 Special Subject Rooms like Art, Music, SUPW, Geography and Psychology. There are 3 well equipped Science Laboratories, 03 Computer Labs, Maths. Lab., Large and well stocked Library, Audio - Visual rooms, Examination room, Administrative block, Staff Rooms, Conference Hall, Activity Hall (equipped with LCD Projector), Amphi- theatre, Auditorium, Indoor Games Section, T. T. Room, Medical rooms, Stores and 14 sets of Lavatories and Washrooms for students and staff. There is a separate wing for K.G. Classes having Garden, Play Field, Toys' Room and other facilities. The entire building is well ventilated and properly lighted.



Our Belief: Holistic Development.....

A number of group-wise Co-curricular Activities are regularly held in the Vidyalaya. Rather these are part and parcel of Vidyalaya Curriculum. All students are divided into four Houses namely Tilak, Patel, Subhash and Lajpat Rai House. Many house wise programmes are organised during the year. Inter Class Competitions in Co-curricular Activities and Games & Sports are held from time to time. Our Students have also participated in a number of Inter School Competitions in the past and have won many Running Shields, Prizes and Merit Certificates. Annual Games & Sports Meet and Annual Prize Distribution Function are regular features of the Vidyalaya. Our students play Volleyball Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Badminton, Basketball, Handball, Baseball and Table Tennis throughout the year and participate in all the Field items, Races, Jumps and Throws. Afternoon games are organised for interested students throughout the year.













More About Us.....

- The Vidyalaya is a single shift school, starting at 7.50 a.m. The Academic Session of the Vidyalaya is from April to March each year.
- In this Vidyalaya, so called "Donation" is never charged, collected and accepted at any time.
- All members of the staff are highly qualified. Appointments are made strictly on merit with the assistance of Experts from outside. The staff members are paid as per the Government Pay Scales, with all admissible allowances and their salary is deposited regularly in their bank accounts.
- Members of the staff are not permitted to take private tuitions. Remedial teaching is done to the educationally backward children after school hours.
- There is 'Child Centered' education in the Vidyalaya. It is not only that the education is imparted by using scientific modern methods of teaching and latest educational equipments but also to make the "Child Centered" education in the real sense, the entire organisation and setup in the Vidyalaya has been designed to keep the child in focus.
- The education in the Vidyalaya is not 'Examination and Information' oriented but ' Learning and Character building' oriented. In the words of Swami Vivekanand "Education for Man-making and Nation-building" is given in the Vidyalaya. Moreover, the Vidyalaya strives to create love for the National and International understanding amongst the students.
- Refresher courses for the teachers are arranged from time to time so that they may be well acquainted with the new developments in theory and practice of education.
- A balance in Curricular, Co-curricular and Extra-curricular Activities is maintained.
- The Training in Scouting & Guiding is also given to the students to inculcate the virtues like truthfulness, patriotism and service to the needy.
- Three Ds-Dress, Drill and Discipline are very important in the Vidyalaya. Regularity and Punctuality are strictly observed in all the activities in the Vidyalaya.
- To inculcate the patriotic fervour, humanly values and Bhartiya Jeevan Darshan in the students, Vidyalaya regularly celebrates Jayanties of great Indian Personalities, Educationists, Saints & National Leaders and also celebrates important National and International Days & Festivals.

- The Vidyalaya has achieved remarkable excellence in all spheres.
